	Schedule in your partition ; use SZASECT to assign the room until SZASECT is closed for building, room, and meeting pattern changes for that term after the Optimizer is run.
	Requesting classrooms outside of your partition, 1) consult with the Department which has the classroom in their partition, 2) secure that Department's permission to use the room, and 3) add the course to the Pre-Assignment Request Google Form. Include the justification of the instructional need for the room for vetting by the Associate Deans.
	Report dual, cross-listed, grouped, and dual campus courses by adding them to the Paired Course Form. If this information was indicated in CBAS, there is no need to fill out the Paired Course Form.
